Guidelines and application

Deadlines to apply for Operation Round Up donations are July 1 and January 1. Incomplete applications will be rejected.

Grants are decided by a seven-member board of Roughrider Electric's Membership. If the donation request is not for a medical expense, the board typically likes to see requests for tangible items.

1. Funds shall be disbursed in the general service area of Roughrider Electric Cooperative solely for charitable, education, scientific, health or safety purposes.
2. Organizations must be exempt from Federal Income Taxation under s501 (a) of the Internal Revenue code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future Unites States Internal Revenue Code as a corporation described in s501 (c) (3) of the Code.
3. No funds of the Charitable Foundation shall in any fashion be used to support any candidate for political office or for any political purpose.
4. Not more than \$10,000 will be given annually to any family unit, group, organization, charity, or like organization. Annual individual medical expense grants will not exceed \$2,500. Funding of other agencies annual operating budgets or scholarships are not eligible for a grant from this Foundation. Funding of school trips may be considered if funding is available
5. The Board will not meet less than semiannually to evaluate applications.
6. The Board reserves the right to carry over applications to a later meeting depending on fund availability and other factors.
