Call 8-1-1 or make a request online by visiting: www.ndonecall.com. Be sure to make the request three business days before you start.

HAIT

Wait three business days for a response to your request. Affected utilities will send a locator to mark any underground utility lines.

CONFIRM

Confirm that all affected utilties have responded by comparing the markers to the list of utiltlies the 8-1-1 call center notified

4 **RESPECT** 

> Respect the markers provided by the affected utilities. They are your guide for the duration of your project.

**DIG CAREFULLY** 

If you can't avoid digging near the markers (within 18-24 inches on all sides) consider moving your projects.
